## Early Childhood Program Registration Placement Procedures

UCS Early Childhood programs enroll more than 1,500 children in nursery and preschool classes. While we try to accommodate all requests for placement at certain schools, it is not always possible to do so. As a guide, we use the following criteria:

1. Currently enrolled students attending an Early Childhood program registering for their home school.
2. Students currently attending an Early Childhood program moving to their home school program.
3. Students currently attending an Early Childhood program and staying with their current teacher.
4. Siblings of currently attending in-district students registering for their home school.
5. Siblings of currently attending in-district students requesting a program other than their home school.
6. New in-district families registering for their home school (phone-in).
7. New in-district families registering for programs other than their home school (phone-in).
8. Siblings of current out-of-district students registering for their program of choice.

All program times and locations are subject to change.

# Nursery & Preschool Program

## General Information

Three and four year old children are welcomed into inviting classrooms by experienced, caring teachers. The classroom environment provides learning opportunities throughout the day. Children interact with each other and teachers during free choice, small and large group activities. Literacy and math skills are introduced and practiced in all activity areas including art, music, housekeeping, story time and block play. Teachers use the Creative Curriculum and Michigan Department of Education Standards to guide their observations, assessments and planning.

All programs are licensed and teachers are qualified by the State of Michigan to teach young children. Teachers and assistants participate in 12 hours of professional development each school year.

All children must be toilet trained, without diapers or pull-ups.

**Registration will be accepted through January 27, 2012.**

**Age:** Nursery - 3 years of age on or before December 1, 2011  
 Preschool - 4 years of age on or before December 1, 2011

**Enrollment:** \$50 payable at registration (\$100 for non-residents)  
 This fee is non-refundable

**Tuition:** The first and last month payments are due by September 1st. The remaining 7 payments are due the first of the month, October through April. Tuition must be paid up to date throughout the school year.

- \$1,215 for the year - \$135 x 9 payments for 3 day (2½ hour) Preschool
- \$1,080 for the year - \$120 x 9 payments for 2 day (3 hour) Preschool

- \$900 for the year - \$100 x 9 payments for 2 day Nursery

# Montessori Preschool and Kindergarten

Montessori is an alternative program offered for preschool and kindergarteners in Utica Community Schools. The curriculum is a blend of the Montessori philosophy and the UCS Learning Standards. It is important to note that participation in this program does NOT guarantee future placement in the first grade at Messmore Elementary School.

Maria Montessori's timeless philosophy guides children's learning in a nurturing environment. Children learn by manipulating materials, which develop meaningful practical skills and academic knowledge. Creativity, respect, responsible behavior, self-discipline and self-motivation are encouraged. Classes are multi-age 3, 4, and 5 year olds together. All teachers are certified to teach through the Michigan Dept. of Education in addition to having a Montessori endorsement. All teachers and assistants participate in 12 hours of professional development annually.

Extended day is an additional program option available to kindergarten children. After lunch, outdoor time and rest, kindergarten children return to the classroom for an additional two hours of hands-on activities. New presentations are made in the areas of geography, science, math and language arts. Skills and insights are expanded throughout the afternoon.

At Beacon Tree Elementary, an extended day option is available for three and four year children following the morning Montessori session. Lunch, outdoor play and rest time follow morning dismissal. Children's literature is the focus of the afternoon activity plans. Language arts, science, art, music and movement come to life through the works of well known children's authors.

All children must be completely toilet trained and out of pull-ups or diapers. Additional child care is available before the morning and following the afternoon Montessori sessions. This program requires separate registration. Registration will be accepted through December 2011.

## Parent and Toddler Together

(Ages 18 months through 3 years)

Come Play With Me is a parent and toddler program that meets once a week. The class offers opportunities for child and parent to learn and grow through art process activities, sensory-motor activities, music and movement, dramatic play, gross motor activities, stories, songs, finger plays and a classroom full of developmentally appropriate toys. Parents will receive information on child development relevant to their child's needs. The majority of class time is free choice, allowing the children to pick the activities that are most attractive to them. This fosters the children's self-esteem, nurtures their budding attention span and allows them to view learning as an active process. All program locations and times are subject to change.

# Carousel & First Playmates Child Care Programs

Our Carousel Child Care and First Playmates staff works closely with parents and their child to establish and maintain cooperative relationships. Prior to enrollment, visits are required in order to help the staffs and families get to know each other. While children attend, ongoing communication with parents continues.



Our full day child care programs provide for the emotional and educational needs of each child. Each classroom is designed to meet the need of a particular age group in a safe, comfortable environment. Nurturing care is combined with age appropriate educational opportunities throughout the day.

The program operates year round (at selected sites) from 7 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday. Tuition is charged on full or half day schedules, minimum schedule required.

**Please call individual sites for additional information.**

Families in need of care for very young children can enroll at our First Playmates program located at the Community Education Center at Walsh. Activities that match the developmental needs of the child are ongoing throughout the day. Infants and toddlers receive gentle care, nurturing and support as they explore and interact with caregivers, other children and playthings. Routines such as feeding, sleeping, and changing are a part of the daily routine and take place in a relaxed, age appropriate manner.

Carousel Child Care for preschool age children is available at three locations in the school district. Teachers plan activities and prepare an environment designed to gradually prepare young children for the more formal school years ahead. Teachers are qualified according to the State of Michigan standards. The Creative Curriculum is followed at all locations. All program locations and times are subject to change.

# HEAD START

## Free Preschool for 3 & 4 Year Old Children



Head Start is a developmentally appropriate preschool opportunity for income-eligible children. The curriculum adopted in the classroom is "Creative Curriculum." Head Start serves 3 and 4 year old children (whose birthdays fall before Dec. 1st of the year for which they are applying) in the following areas; Early Childhood Education, Health Services, Family and Community Partnerships.

Traditional classrooms operate four hours per day, Monday through Thursday. Full day classrooms are offered for parents working and/or going to school full time. Home Base programs offer weekly visits to the child's home, and two group experiences in a classroom twice monthly. Parent Participation is a hallmark of the Head Start program. Opportunities include the following: classroom volunteers, substitute aides, shared governance through Policy Council, and participation in parent committee meetings. # Great Start School Readiness Program

## Free for Qualified Families

Our "Family of Fours" preschool program is available at no charge for families who qualify. Risk factors and eligible income must be verified in order to be eligible. Children may be at risk because of developmental delays, difficult home circumstances (such as divorce, unemployment, serious mental or physical health issues) or limited English, for example. The preschool curriculum emphasizes a positive social and emotional climate, pre-reading, pre-math and science activities. Families join together for field trips that promote learning and fun. Parent participation is required to help support a successful school experience for the child. Contact individual sites to help determine if your child qualifies. Children must be four years old on or before December 1, 2011.

**Make Payments Online!**

COMMUNITY EDUCATION is pleased to bring you the online convenience of our new payment processing system, PaySchools. This program allows you to make child care and preschool payments online via e-check or credit card at your convenience from the Utica Community Schools Community Education web site.

**How It Works**

The first time you access PaySchools, you will be asked to create a username and password. After you login, simply select the item(s) you wish to purchase then choose to pay by e-check or credit card. To pay by e-check (directly debiting your bank account), you will enter your bank’s ABA routing number and personal bank account number. To make your purchase by credit card, enter the account number and expiration date for your VISA, MasterCard or Discover credit card. After you complete your purchase, an e-mail confirmation and receipt will immediately be sent to you. PaySchools uses “Secure Sockets Layer” (SSL) software, requires passwords throughout the program, and does not store personal bank or credit card information to ensure privacy and security for users.
